ElectroComponents needed to replace the ERP system for South Africa as the existing system was reaching end of life. EC currently use SAP in Europe, so the decision was made to adopt SAP for South Africa.

This brought a number of challenges: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• When SAP was first implemented it was heavily modified to fit the EC business model, with many subsequent code releases.• The majority of training material from the implementation had either not been updated or was missing.• Limited resources were available.• No formal Key user network.• Short project timeline.• Significant distance issue.• Low level of computer literacy for some end users | Derek Maynard
